- ⇒ Provide opportunities for programming, bursaries/scholarships & various funding opportunities

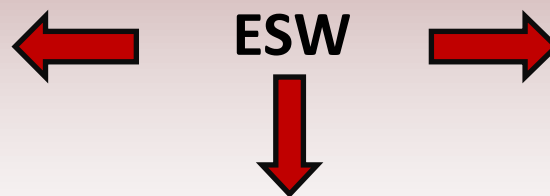
### For the family:

## Financial Support

These require an application which can be found at both CAFN offices & the CAFN website

- ⇒ School Supply Supplementary Fund:  
Grade K to grade 5: \$75.00  
Grades 6 to grade 12/13: \$100.00
- ⇒ Tutoring: \$20 reimbursement for 1 hour period of private tutoring with an invoice & up to 80.00/month. Can increase depending on circumstances
- ⇒ Special Circumstances: To assist families of students who must live away from home to attend school. Please see your ESW for more information.

# Cultural support

- ⇒ Partner with schools to ensure CAFN culture is present & vibrant within that school
- ⇒ Invite Elders & Knowledge keepers into the schools to share their teachings (please contact your ESW if you are interested in coming into the school)
- ⇒ Coordinate seasonal culture camps
- ⇒ Develop and implement cultural programming within schools and our communities
- ⇒ Support teachers and assist with cultural components of the curriculum
- ⇒ Support Grade 12 students with \$150.00 to purchase traditional clothing for the native grad ceremony
